Combining a welcoming street interface and richly layered
landscaping, The McLaren is an enduring architectural statement.

Grounded in nature, this unique building sits prominently at the
corner of McLaren and Walker Street situated in North Sydney's
vibrant historic precinct. With elegant proportions, cascading
terraces and calm materiality. The McLaren seamlessly integrates
with its natural and architectural context, while introducing a
contemporary response that is both distinctive and timeless.

PLACE SENSE OF

Heavily inspired by the fine brickwork, quintessential sandstone, and pastel tones of North Sydney's Victorian terraces, cottages, and leafy streets, The McLaren focuses on human scale and tactility.

Harmonising with the fine-grain heritage of Walker Street, its lush facade and cascading terraces introduce a distinctive contemporary vision. A refined palette of materials and finishes has been carefully selected for their quality and elegance, creating a seamless blend of tradition and modernity.

Conceived as a holistic urban garden, the diverse and verdant sequence of external spaces flows freely within the architecture, contributing to residents' private homes, the shared amenity and the local streetscape.

Based on the philosophy that a positive relationship with nature improves wellbeing, the whole-of-building approach applies a blanket of landscape across all feasible places. Providing opportunities for resident respite and gathering, the landscape has been contemplated as a means to create a vibrant exchange between the building and its residents.

A series of 'curated moments', the building is characterised by three distinct components which form a cohesive whole:

Along Walker Street, the generous Terraces are a contemporary interpretation of the scale, proportion and character of the nearby heritage buildings.

Arriving through McLaren Street, the one-, two-, and three-bedroom Residences sit behind an ordered and calm facade. Integrated balcony planters and full-height glazing ensures abundant light and connection to natural landscape in each apartment.

Perched above, the sculpted and cascading structure of the Penthouse creates a sense of lightness and allows a more playful character to emerge.

Adopting a classic and timeless approach, the residential entry on McLaren Street provides a warm welcome to residents and visitors. Elegant and understated, the entry integrates with the ground floor retail space, creating a vibrant sense of arrival. The considered details of the building's entrance are purposely designed to evoke a luxury hotel experience, providing an inspiring arrival home, day and night.

Inside, the lobby is a sanctuary that sets the tone for the residences above. Continuing the boutique hotel arrival narrative, this extended lounge space is characterised by sculptural furniture and highly crafted architectural detailing.

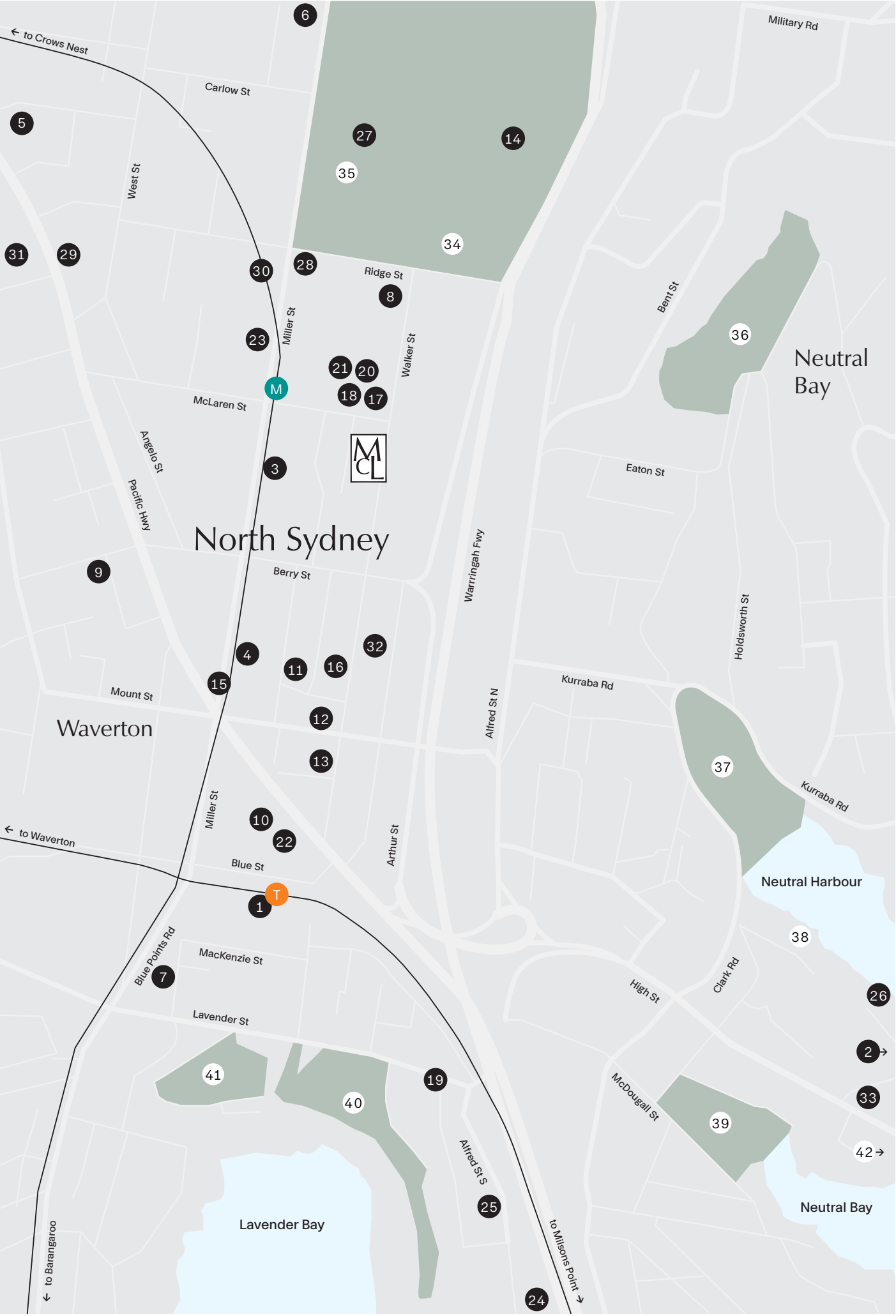
